

HIGHLIGHTS OF YEAR 8 (2017-2018)

Mandate 1: Research

- Five on-going constituent projects
- 16 student projects:
 - Seven student projects launched (six for Master's degrees, one for PhD)
 - Five on-going student projects (one master's, four doctoral)
 - Four students' projects finalized (three for master's, one for doctorate)
- 15 projects with grants undertaken, including:
 - Five new projects (two as principal researcher, three as co-researcher)
 - Six on-going projects (launched before Year 8) (five as principal researcher, one as co-researcher)
 - Two projects involving knowledge transfer
 - One project as collaborator
 - One project as international expert
- 27 on-going scientific involvements and six completed in Year 8

Mandate 2: Outreach

- 57 Publications, including:
 - 14 scientific articles, nine book chapters, 27 research reports, three articles in publications without scientific review, four essays, dissertations or theses.
- 36 scientific communications, four of which were by invitation

Mandate 3: Training

- Contributed to the training of 11 master's and nine doctoral candidates
- Provided training to 15 staff members (students and professionals)
- 33.5 hours of introductory training, reaching 452 students
- 5.5 hours of adult education reaching 345 participants

Mandate 4: Knowledge Transfer

- 27 conferences held for more than 2,100 participants, totaling about 26 hours of knowledge transfer
- Continual dissemination of tools and practice guides
- 31 media contributions
- Continual update of our website
- Creation of corporate folders

Mandate 5: Other Pertinent Activities

- Two distinction awards for the dissertation of Isabelle Maillé, student in the Master's of Social Sciences program at Laval University
- Collaborations with over 100 partners in universities, NGOs, governments, scientists and other international partners
- Hosted Swiss psycho-geriatrician Dr. Serge Zumbach during his scientific leave (nine weeks)
- International contributions: World Health Organization and United Nations
